ADORABLE MISS

OVERVIEW



ADORABLE MISS most recently won the \$100,000 Martha Washington Stakes at Gulfstream Park on July 4th. This makes it her second Stakes win and third overall win in 4 career starts. One race back she was 3rd in the \$200,000 Penn Oaks on June 3rd, beaten 2 lengths to Stakes winners Dynatail and Party Boat. She won the Listed Honey Ryder Stakes at Gulfstream Park in her second start, and has been a VERY consistent turf star overall. She is a full sister to four-year-old Graded Stakes winner Noble Beauty, currently in training with Chad Brown preparing for a summer stakes campaign. She is part of a three horse Mathis Stable draft, with the successful Okla-

homa based owners looking to sell out of their three-year-old prospects to re-load at the yearling sales. This is a filly that is running G1/G2 level numbers as you will see in the ELITE Passport below, and would have been competitive in the G1 Belmont Oaks with her Penn Oaks Rag/Thoro-Graph on July 8th when comparing her numbers to the fillies nominated.

She earned an **84 Beyer**, **13 Ragozin**, and we are waiting for the **Thoro-Graph** number from her July 4th Stakes win.

CURRENT TRAINER - TODD PLETCHER

Todd Pletcher has won too many awards to count. He won both the 2017 KY Derby and 2017 Belmont Stakes. He is based in New York and Florida and does a very good job campaigning all types of horses. Although he has won at an elite 24% lifetime and 300+ Million in purses, most of his G1 wins have come on the dirt. He wins at 26% on the dirt and 20% on the grass.

RACE CAREER OVERVIEW

JULY 4TH - \$100,000 MARTHA WASHINGTON STAKES

ANOTHER STAKES WIN! – () WATCH RACE REPLAY (SHE IS #6)

ADORABLE MISS added to her impressive resume on July 4th winning the \$100,000 Martha Washington Stakes. She had a bullseye on her back going off the 1-2 heavy favorite when the gates opened carrying 123 pounds vs. 2nd place finisher Katinka carrying 117 pounds. She sat in the two path just off the leader under restraint by jockey Tyler Gaffalione. Turning for home she disposed of front runner Katinka and kicked clear never needing to fully extend to get the win by 3/4 of a length. Runner up Katinka ran 8 feet less than Adorable Miss and 3rd place finisher Fancy Kitten 18 feet less than Adorable Miss. Overall she had the tougher trip of the top three carrying more weight. She did what she had to do to get the job done and bring her record to an impressive 3 wins from 4 starts! On to Graded Stakes for this daughter of Kitten's Joy!

JUNE 3RD – PENN OAKS

3RD BY 2 LENGTHS - () WATCH RACE REPLAY (SHE IS #7)

In her third career start **ADORABLE MISS** broke out a touch but was quickly corrected and settled into a nice rating 3rd position in the one mile turf event. Around the far turn she couldn't be held any longer and jockey Javier Castellano let her rip with a bold 3-wide move. As they straightened for home she appeared to be on her way to another Stakes win as Javier was still riding very confident, but as the pacesetter started to edge away, he went to the whip a few times to try to get her home. She tired in the last 50 yards, most likely from the wide run around the turn to finish 3rd. Recent New York stakes winner Party Boat sat a perfect ground saving trip to come up the fence for 2nd money.

MAY 6TH – HONEY RYDER STAKES

1ST BY 2 34 LENGTHS – (🕨 WATCH RACE REPLAY (SHE IS #5)

In her second lifetime start and stakes debut, **ADORABLE MISS** broke well and was a touch head strong early. Because she was so strong early, Elvis Jaramillo was unable to tuck her in for a good turf trip, and she was 3-wide on the first turn. She settled down on the backside, and was content to track in 5th position in the clear. Jaramillo launched her with a 4-wide move that rarely works on turf which gave her every reason to fold, but **ADORABLE MISS** kicked into a top gear the last 1/8th of a mile to win "going away impressively" according to the track caller. She won by 3 ¼ lengths and covered by far the most distance as you will see in the Trakus Chart below.

JAN 22ND - MAIDEN SPECIAL WEIGHT

1ST BY A NECK - () WATCH RACE REPLAY (SHE IS #3)

ADORABLE MISS was well backed in her debut at 4-1, but the betting poured in on the Chad Brown firster for Juddmonte as well as a Mott/Zayat Stables filly. **ADOR-ABLE MISS** broke well but was hard to settle with a 2-wide run into the first turn. Javier got her in the clear down the backside and she easily ranged up to the leader at the ½ mile pole. She did all the work from there, cruising to the lead and taking off down the lane, holding off the Juddmonte favorite Abbreviate.

This filly has shown she can run well at 7 furlongs to 1 1/16th on the turf. We also believe she can handle the longer distances as they write the 3yo races longer. Her full sister is best at 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ on the turf and Kitten's Joy progeny excels up to 1 $\frac{1}{2}$:






THORO-GRAPH

Ran her lifetime top (6) from a (6.5) in her stakes win. These turf figures would be as good as G1 horses in her division. The pattern is perfect. Champion Catch A Glimpse ran a (6) when she won the G1 Belmont Oaks last year.

Perfect pattern of 12-11.5-10.25 with the last figure being her best. Missed some time after her first start with a temperature, but showed no ill effects in her last two efforts being huge.




PEDIGREE

She is by one of the best turf sires in America in, **KITTEN'S JOY**, who has sired earners of more than \$69 million worldwide and was a Champion turf horse himself. He has produced champion turf horses in **BIG BLUE KITTEN** and **STEPHANIE'S KITTEN** as well as recent G1 winner Divisidero and last year's Breeders Cup Juvenile winner **OSCAR PERFORMANCE**.

Her full sister **NOBLE BEAUTY** had a very good 3 year old season winning the G3 Pucker Up at Arlington as well as running 2nd in the G3 Commonwealth Stakes and G3 Regret Stakes, earning \$162,000. She is back training for her 4 year old campaign and looks to continue to add to this pedigree page.

Her 2nd dam **FAVORITE FUNTIME**, by **SEEKING THE GOLD** was a seven time winner, including three Stakes races and the G1 Santa Maria Handicap going 1 1/16th on the dirt.
