PAOLA QUEEN offers breeders a rare combination of an A+ **physical** and a win in one of the most prestigious races for fillies in the U.S. in **the G1 Test Stakes**. This race is one of America's **most** significant indicators of broodmare potential. From 1950-2011, 80% of the G1 Test Winners have gone on to produce a **Stakes Winner**, a **Graded Stakes Winner**, or a **Graded Stakes Placed horse**. **PAOLA QUEEN** has the makings of a top class international broodmare prospect and returns to Keeneland, offering breeders the opportunity to purchase a mare that **history would say** has an **80% chance to produce a Stakes Horse** with **the looks** and **sire power** to back it up.

G1 TEST BY THE NUMBERS

The G1 Test Stakes, for 3 year-old fillies, has been run over seven furlongs at the famed Saratoga Racecourse since 1926. It is one of America's oldest and most storied races and the fillies that have won the G1 Test have gone on to shape the breed as we know it. **PAOLA QUEEN** joined this ELITE group winning the Test in 2016.

Breaking this down even further, these mares have produced **13 G1 Winners**, **44** separate **Graded Stakes Winners**, **33 Stakes Winners**, and **2 Breeders' Cup Winners**. Some notable progeny include **Dayjur (Champion and Sire)**, **Majestic Warrior (G1 Hopeful Winner)**, **George Vancouver (Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf)**, **Concern (G1 Breeders' Cup Classic)**, **Dreaming of Julia (G1 Frizette)**, and **Indian Vale (4X Graded Stakes Winner)**.

In a sport of uncertainty that is a remarkable number!

RACE CAREER OVERVIEW

PAOLA QUEEN ran faster than previous winners **Capvorting**, **Sweet Lulu**, **Contested**, **Turbulent Descent**, **Champagne d'Oro**, **Flashing**, **Indian Blessing**, and **Dream Rush** to name a few. In fact this was the third fastest time in the last 10 runnings and dating back to the first running of the G1 Test at 7 furlongs in 1923 this time was in the top 26%.

This was the defining moment of **PAOLA QUEEN**'s career. **PAOLA QUEEN** and Luis Saez had the presence of mind to sit patiently behind a speed duel (21.7 and 43.50) that developed in front of them between Kareena and G1W Off the Tracks. Two-time G2W Lewis Bay joined the leaders on the turn for home as **PAOLA QUEEN** bided her time. G2W Lightstream made a mid-stretch bid for the win but it was **PAOLA QUEEN** with her quick turn of foot and perfectly timed run that won this historic race in a speedy 1:22.32.

PAOLA QUEEN drew the inside hole and was forced to deal with a sloppy track on the rail. Nonetheless, she broke well and set the pace as G2W Go Maggie Go and G1W Off The Tracks sat in behind. Going into the far turn, Go Maggie Go moved up heading **PAOLA QUEEN** entering the stretch while Off The Tracks made a strong bid. **PAOLA QUEEN** showed grit and determination to battle on hard and defeat heavy favorite Off The Tracks.

PAOLA QUEEN spent the winter and early spring in Ocala with the intention of returning to G1 company in 2017. Unfortunately, one thing after another forced her to retire. It was April 1st and Tom Ryan and the SF Team made the decision to leave her open for her next owner.

***Paola Queen** won the G1 Test with a **90 Beyer** and **3 ½ Thoro-Graph**. The brilliant multiple G1W Dream Rush won the G1 Test in 2007 with a 3 Thoro-Graph and went on to produce G1 Winner Dreaming of Julia.*

PEDIGREE

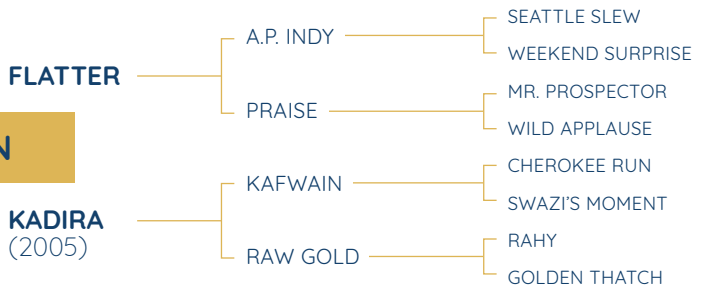
FLATTER retired to Claiborne Farm in 2004 and is enjoying one of his best years at stud in 2017. **FLATTER** is represented by the country's leader for the 3-year-old Eclipse Award in West Coast, the sensational winner of the G1 Travers and G1 Pennsylvania Derby. He has 15% Stakes horses (lifetime) and has 13 Stakes horses in 2017 alone. A son of the great **A.P. INDY**, **FLATTER** has a reputation for adding class to his progeny: he improves his mares by some 24% (1.29 CI vs. 1.61 AEI). As the sire of females like **TARIS (G1)**, **TAR HEEL MOM (G2)** and **CLASSIC POINT (G2)**, **FLATTER** stands to become an important broodmare sire, too. In 2017, he is the broodmare sire of the SWs **NO FAULT OF MINE** (by **BLAME**) and **O DIONYSUS** (by **BODEMEISTER**), and of the exciting 2-year-old **BASE COMMAND**, a \$500,000 yearling son of **TAR HEEL MOM** by **TIZNOW**.

PAOLA QUEEN'S dam, **KADIRA**, was a two-time Stakes winner at two, competing in five Stakes or Graded Stakes events from six furlongs to one mile on dirt and synthetic. She only ran twice as a 3-year-old but in those two races, won yet another Stake and ran 3rd to the ultra-talented **EIGHT BELLES** and eventual G1 winner **PURE CLAN** in the G3 Honeybee Stakes at Oaklawn.

PAOLA QUEEN comes from a long line of Stakes performers and producers. Her 2nd dam, **RAW GOLD**, won the G2 Landaluce S. and the G3 Santa Ynez S. while the G1 Del Mar Debutante winner **POINT ASHLEY** can be found under her 3rd dam.
