

OVERVIEW

HAPPYNESS (GB) is a two-turn **Stakes-placed** European import that is ready to earn her black type win in 2018. She has shown the speed and class to earn her Stakes diploma, but has been unlucky not to get it. She is a turf filly that can go 1 1/16 to 1 1/2 miles and will continue to be a Stakes-caliber horse for next year. Out of a **Danehill** mare and from the family of **G1W Arctique Royal (IRE)**, she has strong residual value in the breeding shed.

CLIFF NOTES

- ✓ **WON FIRST TWO IN US:** Purchased after running 2nd by a neck in Allowance company at Longchamp (very competitive fields, almost equivalent to Stakes company in America), Happyness (GB) was purchased privately and shipped to America. Making her US debut in a \$80,000 allowance N1X at Aqueduct, she came flying off the pace to win by 3 ¼ lengths. She came back a month later and won a \$62,000 N2X at Belmont by 1 ½ lengths.
- ✓ **STAKES-PLACED:** Running widest of all in the 1 ½-mile Flaming Page Stakes, Happyness (GB) turned in a gritty performance to run an unlucky 2nd by a head to one of the top Woodbine turf fillies of 2017 – **Involuntary** – who was just coming off of two Graded stakes placings behind Multiple GSWs **Starship Jubilee** and **Rainha Da Bateria**. She ran 14 feet further than the winner (approximately 1.4 lengths) yet was only beaten by a head.
- ✓ **THROW OUT LAST TWO RACES:** She hit the gate as she broke in the G3 Glenn Falls and was never a threat. In the G3 Maple Leaf, her first try on something other than turf, Happyness (GB) did not care for the Woodbine all-weather surface which was clear as she came down the stretch. This is a turf filly.
- ✓ **BY THE NUMBERS:** Happyness (GB) has run some big numbers in 2017 including an 87 Beyer and topped her (5 ¼) Thoro-Graph from 2016. Although she hated the all-weather at Woodbine she still managed a (7 ¾) Thoro-Graph in her last start. This mare is rounding back into form.
- ✓ **PEDIGREE:** Out of a Danehill mare, Happyness (GB) comes from one of the best families in the European stud book. Her 3rd dam, **Arctique Royal (IRE)** was a G1 One Thousand Guineas winner and produced four Graded Stakes Winners who in turn produced many Graded Stakes Winners. Happyness (GB) is a half to some very well-bred runners including two sisters by **Pivotal** and a brother by **Dubawi**.

HAPPYNESS (GB) will have a 2018 full of Stakes races. She can run over 1 1/8 miles to 1 ½ miles distances on the turf and can compete anywhere in the country. Her pedigree is from a top European female family and she has a bright future ahead of her when it comes time to retire.
