



OVERVIEW

**SON OF A SAINT** is a 3-year-old with a ton of run left in him and **eligible for the Alw-1X condition**. He is by the ever-consistent sire of late-developing class – Speightstown – and comes from a globetrotting family of G1 winners. Diagnosed with bone bruising after two starts at 2, Son of a Saint was given plenty of time by trainer Todd Pletcher and, now at three, his numbers are trending upwards toward Stakes company in 2018.

## CLIFF NOTES

- ✓ **ROUNDING INTO FORM:** He won his first start at three off an 8-month layoff by three lengths and ran a throw-away race at Saratoga next out, getting stuck behind a glacial pace (25.9, 52.2, 1:16.7, 1:39.19). In his most recent start, Son of a Saint ran two-wide for the majority of the race, swung widest of all in the stretch and was  $\frac{3}{4}$  of a length from the winner. He earned an (80) Beyer, (14  $\frac{1}{4}$ ) Rag and (7) Thoro-Graph which **makes his last start, his best.**
- ✓ **STRONG ON THE SHEETS:** His (7) Thoro-Graph on the turf is just outside of Stakes range for a 3-year-old and he is consistently running in the (13) to (15) range on the Ragozin sheets. These numbers are trending towards Stakes company.
- ✓ **DIRT AND TURF:** He paired his Thoro-Graph of (7) over one mile on the dirt with a (7) over one mile on the **turf** in three months.
- ✓ **PEDIGREE:** Son of a Saint fits the Speightstown model of a horse that gets better with age. Of Speightstown's top 10 lifetime performers, 9 were male and their average age of retirement is over 6  $\frac{1}{2}$  years. These older males include Reynaldothewizard, who won a G1 at age seven, and Tamarkuz, who won the G1 Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile at age six.
- ✓ **CONDITIONS:** As a result of bone bruising, Son of a Saint is lightly raced and still owns both his N1X and N2X condition. His Beyer, Thoro-Graph, and Ragozin suggest he can compete in both of these conditions on dirt or turf.
