A start in the June 9th, Grade 1 Acorn Stakes would likely be her next major target **with the goal to end her campaign with Eclipse Award accolades.**

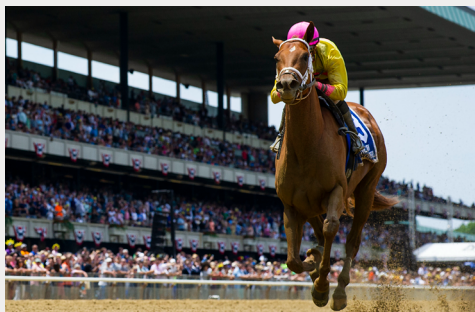

HALF-SIS TO A CLASSIC WINNER- IN FOAL TO A CLASSIC WINNER

Her offspring will be **closely related to MONOMOY GIRL**, who is also by a son of Tapit (Tapizar). Her 2019 foal by Frosted is also bred on the same Tapit/Distorted Humor cross as G1 Florida Derby and G1 Donn Hanicap winner/sire CONSTITUTION.

METMEYER is an exciting young broodmare carrying her first foal- on **1 cover-** by **Tapit's highest rated son at stud FROSTED**. The 2yo colt, also by Tapizar, is currently trained by Brad Cox and was a \$175,000 yearling, purchased prior to Monomoy Girl's first Stakes win. Their dam, Drumette, also has a yearling colt by **Palace Malice**, a weaning colt by **Shackleford** and has been bred to **Mastery**.

As the **ONLY half-sister** to four-time Grade 1 winner and likely 3-year-old filly Champion **MONOMOY GIRL**, Metmeyer offers buyers a rare-opportunity to **tap into a history-making family**.
