was a dazzling winner of Belmont's

FRIZETTE S. (G1)

by 2 lengths, defeating the eventual 2YO Filly Champion **VEQUIST** and the eventual Prioress S. (G2) winner **CILLA**.

She stopped the clock in **1:35.82**—just two ticks off the multiple G1 winner **JACKIE'S WARRIOR** ran in his winning effort in the **Champagne S. (G1)** on the same day.

She earned a blazing **95 Beyer**—incredible feat for a 2YO—and a **9- Ragozin** for the second consecutive time, the **2nd fastest Ragozin for any 2-year-old filly in 2020**.

DAYOUTOFTHEOFFICE

stayed undefeated, dominating the

SCHUYLERVILLE S. (G3)

at Saratoga by a widening **6 lengths**.

She ran a very impressive **9- Ragozin**, the fastest figure for a 2YO filly of the Saratoga meet.

DAYOUTOFTHEOFFICE

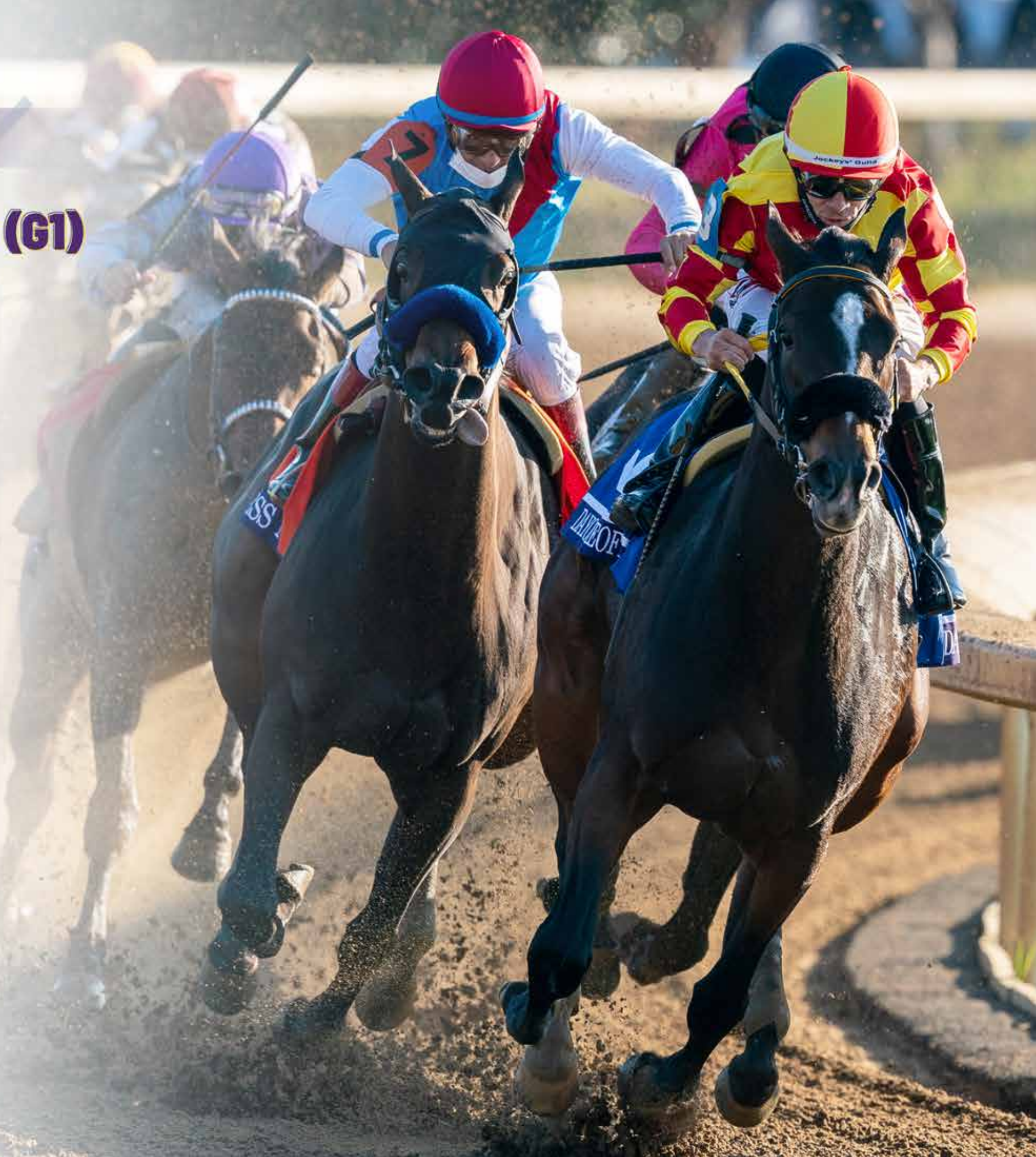

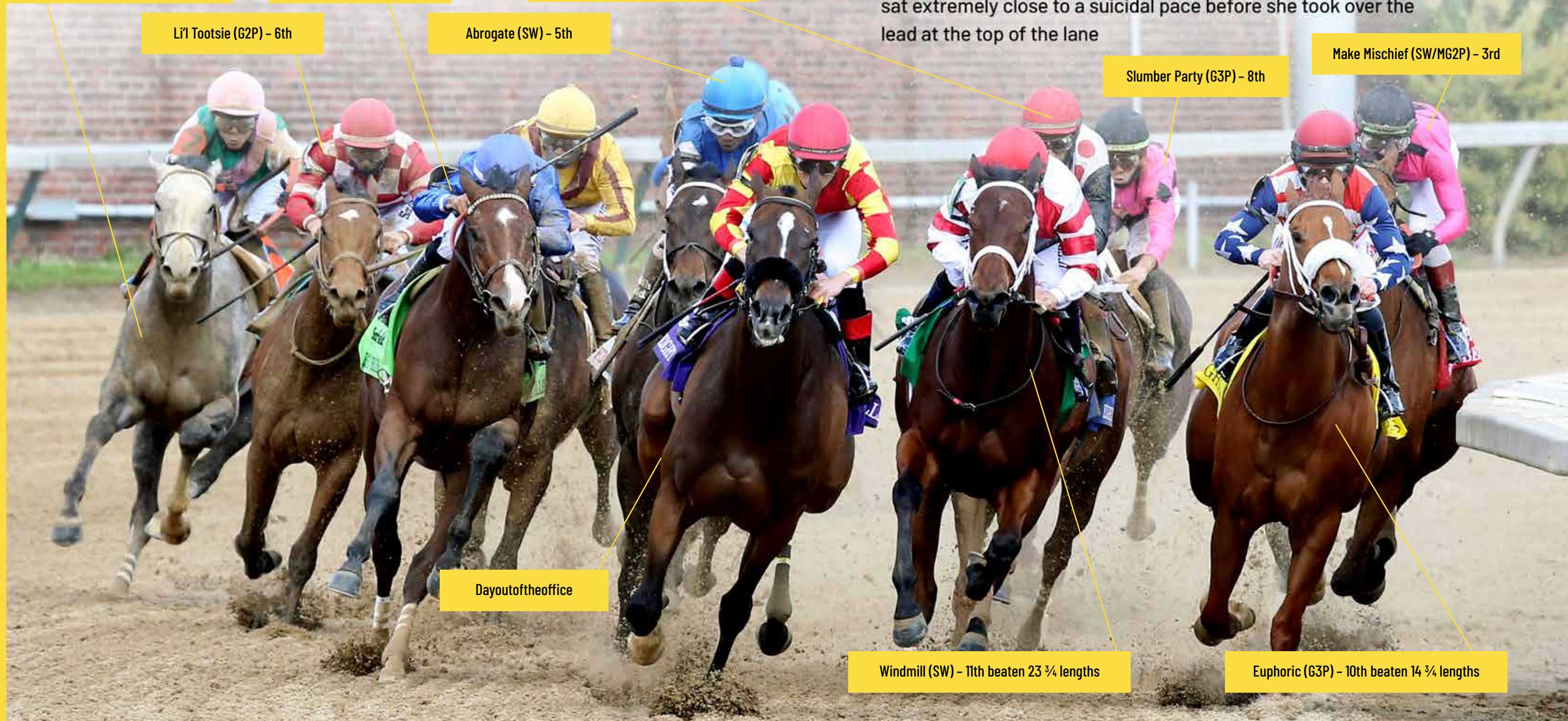

DAYOUTOFTHEOFFICE

is just **the second G1-winning daughter of Into Mischief to be offered at public auction, putting her in rarified air.**

She is the fourth foal out of the 13-year-old Indian Charlie mare Gottahaveadream, **herself a half-sister to G1 Forego winner Here Comes Ben.** Gottahaveadream is also responsible for daughters Gottahaveaholiday, who sold for **\$240,000 to Coteau Grove at Keeneland November** last year, and Felicita, who sold for **\$250,000 to Alpha Delta at the Keeneland December Digital sale.**

Gottahaveaholiday is in foal to top sire **Quality Road** and is due to have her first foal next year, while Felicita had a foal by **Not This Time** this year. Gottahaveadream also has a yearling colt by Bolt d'Oro, the #3 leading first-crop sire of yearlings in 2021.

DAYOUTOFTHEOFFICE's 3rd dam is the **G1-winning Race the Wild Wind**, a mare responsible for the **G1-winning King Charlemagne**, as well as the **dam of G1 Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile winner Albertus Maximus** and his half-brother, **G1 Champagne winner and sire Daredevil.**

DAYOUTOFTHEOFFICE had **brilliant speed, exceptional class, and a pedigree to match.**

As only the second G1-winning daughter of her sire to go through the auction ring, **DAYOUTOFTHEOFFICE represents an uncommon opportunity** to purchase a filly who looks the type of mare to produce a Classic American dirt horse.

It is difficult to put into words what a filly like Dayoutoftheoffice means to us at Siena Farm. As just the third G1 winner bred and campaigned by our team, she gave us some amazing days at the racetrack.

Her 2-year-old campaign was nothing short of excellence, winning her first 3 starts by a combined margin of 12 $\frac{3}{4}$ -lengths, handily defeating the rest of her class in each contest.

She put herself in elite company when earning the rare distinction of becoming a Graded Stakes winner at Saratoga, dominating the G3 Schuylerville by 6-lengths. This display of raw talent and effortless speed gave our team a glimmer of her brilliance to come.

When called upon for her biggest test to date in the G1 Frizette, she took our breath away. She was effortless in her defeat of eventual Breeders' Cup winner and Champion Juvenile Filly, Vequist. The thrill she gave us that day as breeder and co-owner will last a lifetime.

With her win in the G1 Frizette, Dayoutoftheoffice solidified herself as Into Mischief's BEST 2-year-old filly to date. Furthermore, she is just the second Grade 1 winning filly by her exemplary sire to ever come to public auction.

Dayoutoftheoffice is a rare commodity. She showed exceptional talent on the track and has the physical size, scope, and substance to match. She possesses the traits sought-after by so many breeders: precocity, speed, and most of all, brilliance.

We are so proud of Dayoutoftheoffice and can't wait to watch her be at the top of her class in her next career as well.
