proved to be in a different class in the **Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf (G1)**, winning by nearly 3 lengths and remaining unchallenged the entire race.

Her romp in the Breeders' Cup was the final pearl on the necklace to complete a **perfect three-for-three** campaign as a 2-year-old, stamping herself as **Timeform's highest-rated juvenile filly** in the world and earning a nomination for **Eclipse Champion 2-year-old Filly**.

is by one of Europe's hottest sires, **Lope de Vega**, who has been responsible for **13 individual G1 winners** including Champion Belardo, Newspaperofrecord, and Lucky Vega.

AUNT PEARL is just the second foal out of the Hurricane Run mare, Matauri Pearl, and an already strong family is set to become even better. AUNT PEARL's 2-year-old half-sister, **Fall in Love (Sea the Stars)**, was a **\$527,444 yearling purchase at Arqana October last year and she is already a winner**, having broken her maiden in France in September. AUNT PEARL's yearling **full brother was also a success at the yearling sales, having sold for \$514,385 at Tattersalls October Book 1** to Blandford Bloodstock. Matauri Pearl has a foal on the ground by standout French stallion Le Havre.

Matauri Pearl was a Champion at three in Europe herself and is a full sister to Wekeela, a G3W/G1P mare whose first foal is the impressive British maiden winner and John Gosden trainee Millennial Moon. **Wekeela sold for \$2,547,342 at Tattersalls December to Qatar Racing** and she has a yearling colt by European Champion **Roaring Lion** and a colt foal on the ground by the sensational **Kingman**.

Further down in AUNT PEARL's pedigree, we find more top-class European racehorses, including French Highweight 3-year-old and

dual Classic winner Brametot, as well as the multiple G1W and sire Monsun.

AUNT PEARL screams class from top to bottom. Between her **devastating speed, brilliance on the racetrack**, and her **standout pedigree with foals by Lope de Vega, Kingman, and Roaring Lion all in the immediate pipeline**, AUNT PEARL provides an exceedingly rare opportunity to purchase a cornerstone broodmare who has all the parts buyers are looking for: **speed, precocity, pedigree, talent**.
