

G3W JUVENILE IN FRANCE

3RD BEHIND NEXT OUT G3W

- KUBRICK, a G3 winning ½-brother to MG1W Raging Bull, comes into the sale off a narrow 3rd place finish in a third-level allowance at Aqueduct, finishing just behind next out G3 Knickerbocker winner Andthewinneris and Battle of Normandy, who has won four races in a row, including the G3 River City last weekend.
- KUBRICK made his US debut earlier this year when taking an allowance at Tampa by 3 1/4 lengths, defeating five stakes winners in the process. That effort was followed up by a couple of graded stakes tries, including the G1 Makers Mark Mile.
- KUBICK was an excellent 2yo in France, taking a maiden race at Deauville, after which he came right back three weeks later to take the G3 Prix des Chenes at Longchamp. In 2023 at three, he was beaten less than four lengths in the G1 French 2000 Guineas



RAGOZIN


KUBRICK (IRE) earned a 9 RAGOZIN FIGURES in his
US debut. A 9 RAGOZIN is a number that is good
enough to win graded stakes going a mile on the
turf. This number compares favorably with some of
the better US turf milers this year:

THORO-GRAPH

KUBRICK (IRE) has been **very consistent** on his Thoro-Graph sheet. He most recently has **paired 5 1/2 Thoro-Graphs** and could likely take a step forward on on that speed figure metric next year as a 5-year-old.

Last seen running 3rd, KUBRICK earned a 91 Beyer, 5-1/2
Thoro-Graph, =14" Ragozin last out when 3rd in a N3X
allowance behind BATTLE OF NORMANDY who went on to
win the G3 River City and ANDTHEWINNERIS who won the
G3 Knickerbocker.



PEDIGREE

- > KUBRICK, by the great DUBAWI, whose £350,000 stud fee is one of the most expensive in the world, is out of the Mr. Greeley mare ROSA BONHEUR and is a ½-brother to MG1W AND STALLION RAGING BULL.
- > ROSA BONHEUR sold last week at the Keeneland November Sale for \$375,000 in-foal to JUSTIFY. KUBRICK has a yearling ½-sister by Wootton Bassett.
- KUBRICK is also from the family of G3W/G1P EXXTRA, who finished 2nd in the Maurice de Gheest earlier this year.
